Steve Dawks ran through the accounts for 2021, as circulated and attached. We had received income of £2593.23, with expenditure of £676.63 – of which £200 was a donation to BBC Children in Need on behalf of the late Lall Singh. Excess of income over expenditure was £1916.60 and we remained in a healthy and stable financial position, with a closing balance of £8326.39.

All elements were approved and accepted. Proposed by Steve Rawlings and seconded by Richard Young.

Election of Officers:

Geoff Russell, Karl Williams and Steve Dawks stood for re-election as Chair, Secretary and Treasurer respectively. No further nominations were received, so all were elected unanimously.

Election of Committee:

Vitor Fernandes-Neto stood for election as Deputy Webmaster; proposed by Rob Corbett and seconded by John Page.

Ian Harris and Dave Harrop retired by rotation and stood for re-election.

No further nominations were received so all were elected unanimously.

Any Other Business:

Details had been circulated to all members, and the Committee had agreed to fund the entry fee of £25 per rider.
